




- Frequent headaches or eye strain
- Avoidance of reading or close work
- Covering one eye while reading
- Poor reading comprehension
- Short attention span during visual tasks

IMPORTANCE OF EYE EXAMS

 Detects issues beyond 20/20 vision, like eye coordination & focusing problems.

 Recommended annually, starting in first grade.





VISUAL SKILLS ESSENTIAL FOR LEARNING

- Eye teaming: Coordinating both eyes to work together.
- <u>Tracking:</u>
 Moving eyes smoothly across a page.
- Focusing:

 Maintaining clear vision at different distances.
- Visual processing: Interpreting and understanding visual information.

 & visual efficiency.
